We aim to instil a progressive mind set and nurture leaders of tomorrow, who will succeed in th world and yet retain and unmistakable Indian ethos and Sanskar.






INFRASTRUCTURE

AN IMAGINATIVE CURRICULUM


Pre-Primary School: The approach at Pre-primary is 'child centered'. It is development oriented and emphasises on the child's interaction with his environment. The main objectives at this level are the development of social, language, physical and motor skills, creative expression, aesthetic and cognitive skills.

Primary School: A thematic approach is designed to stimulate children through various inter-active sessions and activities. Innovative, contemporary concepts are projected and re-inforced through different subjects — 'learning by doing' culminating in 'joyful learning' is the ultimate goal. A blend of mass participation along with an emphasis on a strong sense of individuality is stressed upon.

Middle School: The emphasis at middle school, besides following the NCERT guidelines, is on developing the right study habits and securing an indepth knowledge of the subject. The curriculum is research-oriented based on teamwork. Selection of matter and presentation is given utmost importance. Personality development, value education and coping with peer pressure are stressed upon at this stage.

There is an in-house infirmary capable of giving first aid, and is overseen by the visiting doctor and two resident nurses. In case of an emergency the child is rushed to the nearest hospital.

Entrance Tests / Interviews / Interaction:

- a) There will be a written test for students seeking admission to Classes KG upwards. Only those candidates who clear the written test will be called for an interview.
- b) Results will be displayed on the Notice Board on the dates specified. 2.2

Admission Formalities:

- a) Successful candidates whose names are included in the list must pay the fees by the dates indicated on the list, displayed on the School Notice Board, otherwise admission will automatically stand cancelled.
- b) Parents are requested to carefully fill and submit the Admission Form, Parent Teacher Association Form. Transportation Form (where applicable) and Medical Form at the time of payment of fees. These forms are enclosed in this booklet.
- c) The date of birth of child is required to be supported by the birth certificate in original issued by the Municipal Corporation / Local bodies as applicable, along with a certified photostat copy thereof. An affidavit or any other evidence is not acceptable in support of birth certificate. It is to be attached with the Admission Form for Classes Nursery & KG. For Class I & above, Transfer Certificate is to be attached, For Class V & above Transfer Certificate must be counter signed by the concerned State Education Authority.
- d) The admission card will be issued to parents only after all four forms are duly filled and the admission formalities are completed.
- e) Parents are to report to the reception counter on the dates specified in the joining instructions, along with the admission card. The ward will not be allowed to attend classes if the admission card is not produced.
- f) Your ward has to report in complete School Uniform, along with books and stationery as prescribed by the school. (Uniform, Books and Stationery are available at the school book shop/uniform shop).



Fee Regulations

Fees for the first year is payable in advance and from the second year may be paid in two installments Statement of Dues is issued towards the end of September and March and is to be honoured within 15 days of receipt of bills, failing which late fee is levied. Recurring expenses borne by the child on items not covered in the Fee Schedule attached, will be an additional cost to the students.

- Fees are charged from the 1st of April, whether the student joins on the date or not. Fees are payable for the entire year irrespective of the fact that a student stayed or studied in the school/school hostel for a part of the session.
- Please counsel and prepare you ward before making him/her join the hostel so that he/she is not tenuous in his/her adjustment in the hostel.
- As the availability of the seats is limited, the school shall not refund the fee in case of any withdrawal in mid session.
- 4. Late corners shall be fined an amount of Rs. 500/- per day.
- 5. Students will not be allowed to return to school after the vacations, unless the accounts for previous school term has been settled in full. No reduction is allowed for broken periods. All dues must be cleared before the child leaves the school.
- The school reserves the right to initiate legal action to recover outstanding dues, from parents who withdraw their child from school without clearing outstanding payments.
- 7. All disputes will be subject to the jurisdiction of Dehradun courts only.
 - Permission to attend special functions at home shall not be usually granted, as a safeguard both for the sake of health and study.
 - 2. Parents may visit or take their children out, for a maximum of two outings a month on Sundays and Holidays. Only one Night Outing a Month is Permitted on last Weekend of the Month. Children can be picked on Friday after school and must return to school latest by 6.30 p.m on Sunday. Besides parents, no other relatives will be permitted to take the child out for the night.
 - Parents are requested to discourage frequent visits and outings, as the child will then take very long to settle down and concentrate on his/her studies.
 - When permitted to go out, children must be accompanied by their parents or by some duly authorized person. On their return they must report to the Matron/House Master.
 - No student will be allowed out with friends or relations unless a written permission from the parents is available.
 - Letters of Authorization should be written on official letter head paper with complete details. No child will be allowed to go out with a brother or sister studying in other local schools.
 - A child admitted as a Boarder student will under no circumstances be permitted to convert to a Day Scholar /Day Boarder in the middle of the academic session. Different set of rules & regulations will apply to admission of day scholars.



Home Away From Home

Hostel

Suditi Global Academy has taken special pride in providing matchless boarding facilities for students from classes IV to XII for boys. It also provides round the clock medical care to the boarders.

The Hostels provides the structure and order which all youngster need and at the same time of warm surroundings of an extended home so that students feel comfortable with provision of all the comforts and security.

Remedial Classes

The remedial classes are the school's initiative to help bring the comparative slow learners and low scorers at par with the rest of the class. Under this set up, a list is formulated at the start of each academic year; of students whose performance has been consistently low. A special 60 minute slot is created after the school's time table, towards the end of every day. The idea of keeping this slot within the regular working hours of the school is to avoid stay backs and discourage unhealthy demarcations between the students. A remedial slot is allocated to each subject in an efficiently planned manner, so as to ensure that all the subjects are assigned equal slots within a week.

Mess

A modern mess providing nutritious and hygienic food. According to Mess Committee (Constituted by Hostel Students). Reports, Mess menu can change depending upon the session and choices. Its kitchens are widely acclaimed for exceptionally hygienic preparations of vegetarian food with the help of ultra modern appliances.



HOSTEL RULES

The hostel is open for students of class IV to XII

1. If a child joins the hostel, he/she will not be permitted to be a day scholar in the ongoing session. If in dire need of leaving the hostel, hls/her case may be considered by he/she will have to pay

the full fees for the full

session.

- 2. The Principal has power to refuse requests of boarders to be sent home to attend religious festivals, marriage parties and other functions.
- 3. The Principal will issue instruction to the parents/guardians well in time regarding the departure of boarders before all vacation.

5. No child is allowed to visit know to celebrate his/her birthday. If the parents are desirous of celebrating the birthday of their ward/wards they are most welcome to celebrate it in the school with the children of his/her class during school hours.

Students will be placed in the dormitories according to their age and class.

- 7. Recreational facilities like Indoor games, Television and newspapers are provided to the boarders.
- 8. Any damage caused to the school property will be recovered from students along with suitable fine.
